2. Sprinkler Waiver requested for Rockfon 4849 S. Austin Ave., due to a second-floor office remodel.

3. I received notification from J & J Trucking that they are looking to build a new building on Monitor. They are also looking to demo 5001 S. Monitor Ave after the New year. The new building would be on the properties of 5001 & 5005 S. Monitor and 4900 W. 51<sup>st</sup> Street.
4. D/C Staidl will be appointed to the position of President of the Illinois Fire Inspectors Association on December 12, 2024 for the 2025 term.




