Engineer Nick Chevas attended the MABAS Haz-Mat validation this month. This is the annual MABAS validation of the Division 21 Haz-Mat Team.

Vehicle, Equipment, House Maintenance, Other:

Five members on leave of absence (Mina, Sanchez-Molina, McFarland, Gresik, Pawyza)

We still have open shifts, but are getting better.

New hires for May are FF/PM Clark Burkhart, Single Role Paramedic Megan Collins, and FF/EMT Tyler Waznis.

FF/PM Brian Corcoran resigned due to full-time job responsibilities.

Our International Ambulance is still listed for sale with Brindle Mountain Apparatus. So far, we have only had one inquiry. The current price is \$20,000.00.

We have been awarded the 2025 OSFM SEG Grant. The Grant award is \$18,531.00 and is being used to purchase a Combi-tool (extrication tool) for E905. Now all three of our fire apparatus have at least one extrication tool. S907 has two sets (1 hydraulic and 1 battery)

E905 should be back from the Body Shop in July.

The lights on the front of the building have been completed. The lights were ordered when the siding project was completed but never installed.

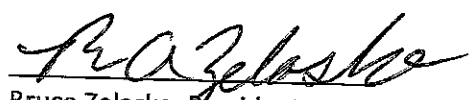
